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Eline van Overbeeke is dedicated to advance the implementation of innovative healthcare solutions through multi-stakeholder collaboration. She holds a PhD in Patient and Public related Health Research from the University of Leuven in Belgium. During her time at the University of Leuven she was a researcher, and later Steering Committee member, of the IMI PREFER project on patient preferences and contributed to additional multi-stakeholder debates on that topic through ISPOR and HTAi patient preference and patient involvement working groups. While at the University of Leuven, she did a Marie Skłodowska-Curie RISE secondment at the Council of Canadian Academies, where she worked on the 'From Research to Reality' multi-stakeholder project regarding the approval and use of somatic gene therapies in Canada, commissioned by the National Research Council Canada. She is currently a Health Economics and Outcomes Research Manager at Pfizer. In her current role, Eline has co-led WP2 of the IMI EHDEN project, on Real World Data (RWD) and federated networks and is currently a Steering Group member of the payer-led multi-stakeholder initiative Real World Evidence for Decisions (RWE4Decisions) looking at how RWD can be used in Health Technology Assessment of highly innovative therapies.
