Jan Skriwanek is the German Representative of the IHI States Representative Group (SRG) on behalf of the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF).

He is working at DLR Project Management Agency as scientific officer for the German National Contact Point Health since 2007. National Contact Points (NCPs) for Horizon Europe serve as liaisons between the research community and the European Commission, multipliers of information on calls for proposals and framework programme issues. He is responsible for the "Health" themes in Horizon Europe with a focus on the Cluster Health and especially on IHI.

Jan Skriwanek has actively followed the implementation of the predecessor initiatives IMI and IMI 2. Since 2010 he was the German Representative of the IMI States Representative Group (SRG) on behalf of the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). He was vice chair of the IMI2 SRG from 2020-2022 and has been elected as vice chair for the IHI SRG in March 2022.

He has also been/is actively involved as expert in various EU committees and expert groups such as the Program Committee of the Cluster Health in Horizon Europe. From 2007-2010 he supported the German chairmanship of the ESFRI (European Strategy Forum for Research Infrastructures) Biomedical Science Roadmap Working Group for evaluating large-scale Biomedical Research Infrastructures to be created in Europe.
