Before joining the European institutions, Leslie has worked in various types of organisations (medtech industry, Contract Research Organisation, consultancy, public hospital, French HTA agency) and at various stages in the lifecycle of health interventions, from early clinical development, to HTA, collection of real-world evidence and considerations for implementation in health systems.
