Sibilia Quilici (MBA, MSc) is the Executive Director of Vaccines Europe, the specialised vaccine industry group within EFPIA, the European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries and Associations.

Sibilia holds an International MBA in entrepreneurship and two MScs in Econometrics and Health Economics & Biostatistics.

Starting as a consultant in Health Economics and Outcomes Research in the UK in 2003, she subsequently moved to the joint venture Sanofi Pasteur MSD (SPMSD) created in 1994 to develop and commercialize vaccines originating from both companies' pipelines to improve and promote public health in 19 European countries. There, Sibilia was responsible of the health economic modelling for the pediatric vaccines. She then evolved from health economics to public affairs and manage the company participation to the European public private partnership marketplace on active and healthy ageing (the European Innovative Partnership on Active & Healthy Ageing), focusing on e-health, health literacy, patient empowerment, interoperability & integrated care.

At the closure of the joint venture in 2016, Sibilia took over the role of European Public Policy Lead for Vaccines for MSD and contributed to the development of the company reputation in vaccines in Europe.

Since January 2021, Sibilia leads Vaccines Europe, representing the major innovative research-based vaccine companies operating in Europe, including small and medium-sized enterprises.

With more than 12 years of experience in working on vaccines, she holds a track record in studies valuing the full benefits of preventative measures (such as vaccines), from a micro and macro socio-medico-economic perspective, addressing all relevant stakeholder concerns (government, industry, society, healthcare professionals and citizens).
