Andromachi's work focuses on the scientific support of policies for public health protection and safer chemicals management. She has been engaged with the preparation and implementation of European partnerships (under Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe) and of large European projects (under the FP5, FP7 and Life+).

Her research involves issues related to personalized assessment of citizens' and workers' exposures to harmful chemicals and the possible effects on health, cross-border harmonization and quality assurance, bioethics and personal data protection, biobanking, science communication and stakeholders' engagement. Her laboratory also develops and applies analytical methods for the official governmental monitoring and control of marketed products, under relevant national and European regulations.

She served on several Working Groups, Councils and Committees at national and European level, with varied focus, including the protection of children's health.

Andromachi holds a Ph.D. and a M.Sc. degree in Biochemistry from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, USA, an M.B.A. degree from the University of Cyprus and a B.Sc. degree in Chemistry from the University of Akron, USA, as a Fulbright scholar. She was a post-doctoral fellow at the University of Gothenburg and at Stockholm University and a visiting lecturer at the Department of Chemistry of the University of Cyprus. She is the recipient of several awards and recognitions.
