Scientific Director of the Centro Cardiologico Monzino IRCCS hospital (Italy), the largest European stand-alone cardiovascular centre in Europe.

Internationally known as a pioneer in Italy in gene therapy for peripheral arterial diseases and cardiac regenerative therapy with cardiac stem cells, he is the head of one of the most scientifically productive cardiovascular laboratories in Europe. Besides the intense clinical activity, his scientific interests encompass the understanding of the pathogenesis of the inherited cardiomyopathies, and the development of novel therapies to prevent sudden cardiac death.

Professor Giulio Pompilio graduated in Medicine and Surgery and specialized in Cardiac Surgery at the University of Milan in 1989 and 1994, respectively, with highest honours.

He is currently Scientific Director of the Centro Cardiologico Monzino IRCCS hospital, Senior Staff Surgeon and Director of the Laboratory of Vascular Biology and Regenerative Medicine Unit at Centro Cardiologico Monzino IRCCS, Associate Professor of Cardiac Surgery at University of Milan, School of Medicine.
